HOW TO ACCESS DATABASES FROM OFF CAMPUS ONLY For City College ID Holders

- 1) Go to **City College Library** homepage: <http://www.cuny.cuny.edu/library>
- 2) Click “**Quick Links to Selected Resources**” – At bottom of page
- 3) Click on the database you wish to access
- 4) **RETURN USERS:** Sign in with email and password you created.
- 5) **FIRST TIME USERS:** Type in your 14-digit CCNY ID barcode.
 - a. You now create email logon and password.
 - b. Then sign in as a “Return User”
- 6) **FORGOT PASSWORD:** Type in your 14-digit CCNY ID barcode.
